Dinant

Why not join us on this new exciting tour to Wallonia in southern Belgium. Our base for this 4 night stay will be at Dinant which is the second largest town in the Belgian region of Condroz and one of the most important tourist centres in the Ardennes. Thanks to its delightful situation in the Upper Meuse Valley below precipitous limestone rocks, crowned by a mighty citadel, Dinant has become a very lively tourist resort.

Highlights of this tour will include:

A twilight costumed guided tour of the haunted Castle - La Roche En Ardenne Castle which will include a reception with local speciality meats, chocolates and drinks.
A guided tour of Les Jardins d'Annevoie the gravity powered water gardens modelled on Versailles.
A tour and tasting at Du Bocq Brewery
A cable car ride to the cliff top citadel in Dinant with unique views of Belgium, Germany and France.
A guided boat ride to a UNESCO world heritage site - 19th century hydraulic lifts. The boat ride goes through and uses the actual lifts and includes a tour of the engine room.

Mercure Dinant

We will be staying at the Mercure Dinant which is a good quality 3* hotel with very large grounds set in a peaceful woodland and located 9 km from the centre of Dinant. This Manor style hotel dating from 1810 has been recently renovated and offers comfortable en-suite accommodation, a heated indoor swimming pool with an outdoor sun deck, 2 tennis courts and a mini golf course. There is a lift to all floors.
