Captivating Cumbria

Gilsland Spa Hotel

The Gilsland Spa Hotel sits 700 feet above sea level, commanding spectacular views over the Cumbrian countryside. Situated just over a mile from the pretty village of Gilsland, visitors can enjoy the magnificent Irthing Gorge, where the River Irthing separates the counties of Cumbria and Northumberland. An added bonus to a stay at Gilsland are the many scenic walks to be found in the Hotel's 140 acres of park and woodland. The hotel offers comfortable en-suite accommodation, Hadrian's Lounge Coffee Shop, Galloways Bar, a gift shop and library. The hotel also has a bowling green, putting green, french boules pitch and croquet lawn with all the equipment available at the hotel. The hotel presents a full programme of bingo, music and entertainment every night which also includes a tea dance before your evening meal.

Excursions

Our day starts with a drive along Military Road visiting Birdoswald Roman Fort which is set in one of the most picturesque locations on Hadrian's Wall. Birdoswald includes a Roman fort, turret and mile castle. A fascinating interactive visitor centre incorporates an historical exhibition and full height replica section of the wall. We continue to Hexham which has an excellent shopping centre with many curiosity shops. They hold the market on Tuesdays.

We also visit the border city of Carlisle with its castle, cathedral and excellent pedestrianised shopping centre. Carlisle Cathedral shows the peaceful face of Carlisle's past. Its 14th century stained glass window and magnificent ceiling looked down on the marriage of Sir Walter Scott and his French born bride. All the threads of Carlisle's colourful life and times are woven together dramatically in the displays of the award-winning Tullie House Museum and Art Gallery. The symbol of Carlisle's strategic importance is the castle, founded by William the Conqueror's son William Rufus. In 1092 and once a prison for Mary Queen of Scots, it is still the home of the King's Own Royal Border Regiment.
