Teignmouth is an historic port on the mouth of the Teign estuary. It is a delightful seaside town with a colourful riverside harbour, a Victorian pier and a handsome esplanade and some beautiful kept gardens.

Brixham is home to a pretty harbour surrounded by some fine old buildings and a handful of pretty colour-washed cottages. In the harbour you can see the replica of the ship the 'Golden Hind' in which Sir Francis Drake sailed around the world.
