Brixham is home to a pretty harbour surrounded by some fine old buildings and a handful of pretty colour-washed cottages. In the harbour you can see the replica of the ship the 'Golden Hind' in which Sir Francis Drake sailed around the world.

Paignton which lies in the centre of the magnificent sweep of Torbay is one of the premier resorts in this area with its long sandy beaches, colourful atmosphere and clear waters.
