## Tour



Due to our successful weekend breaks over the last few years we have pleasure in offering the Yorkshire T.V. Tour to our customers again in 2009. This weekend we will visit many of the film locations associated with the series 'Emmerdale' and 'Last Of The Summer Wine'. Friday en-route to the hotel we will visit Holmfirth, the setting for the 'Last Of The Summer Wine' series. Walk the streets of the town with their fine craft shops, see Nora Batty's steps, 'The Last Of The Summer Wine' Exhibition or have a coffee in Sid's café. On Saturday we travel to Skipton which prides itself on being 'The Gateway To The Dales'. Skipton holds a market on Saturday where you can browse for bargains before continuing to the village of Esholt which was the original 'Beckingdale' in the series, here you will have time for a drink or two in the 'Woolpack'.

Sunday we start the day aboard the steam train at the Keighley and Worth Valley Railway for a pleasant ride into the Yorkshire Countryside. The preserved steam railway is a backdrop for many films and TV programmes perhaps still most famously for 'The Railway Children'. We continue to Haworth which retains much of its character and both the village and the landscape would be recognised by the Brontes today. Main Street offers an interesting variety of shops, tearooms and public houses. You will have the opportunity to visit the Bronte parsonage, where the sisters brought alive the brooding beauty of Yorkshire in the novels such as 'Wuthering Heights' and 'Jane Eyre'.
